

A cooperation between industry and healthcare for a PVC-free blood bag

A project within EU's Life+ Environmental Programme 2011–2017

The objectives are

- to demonstrate that it is possible to produce a PVC-free blood bag that fulfils requirement specification, including CE-labelling
- to increase demand by cooperation with European healthcare in disseminating knowledge and awareness

The four companies participating in the project represent different links in the supply chain for the new bag. The hospital within Region Jämtland Härjedalen is in charge of the handling tests of the bags. Karolinska University Hospital is responsible for evaluating the bag.



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
